One trend is "runner" arrangements. Very low and narrow.



Other arrangements have a tall focal point. This one was hydrangeas, an orchid spray and tulips.





A tip Norma Jean shared for preserving hydrangeas in arrangements is to dip the cut end of the stalk into alum (used in canning). She also said hydrangeas take up a lot of water so are better cut closer to the flower head. The stalk must be in water or connecting with the oasis. Misting twice a day will make them last longer.

Several of the arrangements were raffled off and three Green Thumb members went home very happy.
